National park Kenozero is strictly protected area which represents the model of historical human habitat, the place that managed to preserve the centuries-old history and culture of the Russian North. The high level of the conservation of the cultural landscapes and their valuable elements make the national park Kenozero the unique region with no analogues in Russia or worldwide.

Yet, the thing that makes Kenozero National Park singular is its living culture and the epical heritage of Russia. There are about 100 monuments of cultic and civil architecture in Kenozero, big and small villages with friendly people, ancient monasteries located in remote woodlands, numerous holy forests. In 2004, Kenozero National Park joined the Global Network of UNESCO Biospheric Nature Reserves.

For several years the park has been hosting volunteer projects.

Work. Volunteers will be working in maintaining cultural landscapes of two abandoned villages, Maselga and Guzhovo. Volunteers will assist employees of Kenozero National Park in clearing and maintenance of eco trails around these 2 villages, clearing the cultural landscapes using special equipment (brush cutters, lopping shears, saw).

Accommodation and food. In wooden huts of eco camping fully furnished, with bed sheets and towels. Organised meals in the canteen of the park (volunteers don't need to cook). Different types of Russian banya (sauna). Toilets(outhouses). There is no electricity, but there will be possibilities to charge phones, cameras. Only mobile Internet.

Location & leisure. Volunteers will be based on the territory of eco camping in Maselga village (abandoned village). 5 km from the village Morschikhinskaya, Arkhangelsk Region. 3 hours by car of the park from Nyandoma train station. 14 hours by train from Moscow.

Workshops on folk traditions and crafts (birch bark, clay, ceremonial dolls); swimming in lakes (3 lakes around the camp), different types of Russian banya (sauna). Different excursions on the territory of the park.

Requirements. Volunteers should be ready to work with such tools as brush cutters, lopping shears, saw. Vaccination against encephalitis is recommended. Be equipped with a backpack, no roll-on bags.

Meeting point. Moscow on the 17th of August. Then we take a night train to Nyandoma (14 hours, around 30 euro oneway).

#### Project:

The objective of this project is for volunteers to raise awareness of the issues of animal homelessness, maltreatment and abandonment in Samara. Volunteers will publicize the work of the "Nadezhda" Animal Shelter - providing a refuge to homeless or abandoned animals, by photographing stray animals living on the street and, in contrast, animals that the "Nadezhda" Animal Shelter has rescued and provided care and shelter for. An exhibition at the end of the work camp will aim to address the chasm of difference between the health of those animals which live on the streets without care and those which the "Nadezhda" Shelter has been able to help, and in some cases, successfully re-home. It is hoped the exhibition will raise awareness of the problem of animal welfare and encourage the people of Samara to offer their input with regards to solving this crisis. This project will be the initial part of a continuing commitment to facilitating the work of the "Nadezhda" Animal Shelter.

#### Work:

- Taking photographs of stray animals on the streets of Samara in order to document their poor health and suffering due to the conditions and disadvantages of homelessness.
- Taking contrasting photographs of those animals which "Nadezhda" Animal Shelter has been able to help. The photographs should convey the improved quality of life of these animals; their wellbeing, good health and happiness.
- Organizing, promoting, and overseeing a photographic exhibition on animal welfare in Samara, using the photographs the volunteers have taken. The aim of the exhibition is to provide evidence of the actuality of animal suffering in Samara and invoke the people of Samara into facilitating, by whichever means possible, the work of the "Nadezhda" Animal Shelter.

The language school "Language Plus" has been organizing international language camps for five years. In their camps Russian and foreign volunteers collaborate to organize cultural, educational and sport activities for local children and children from nearby regions aged 7-17.

The mission is to provide every child with a range of opportunities which help him/her to grow and improve themselves as a person.

The aims of the project:

- intercultural exchange;
- raising children's interest in other cultures and tolerance to other nationalities, religions, races;
- learning foreign languages;
- building teamwork and leadership skills;
- discovering and developing children's creative skills ;
- educating children to be leaders with active life position.

Tasks

- Teaching foreign languages to the participants (in the form of playing games, singing songs or improving their language skills through discussions). These include the volunteer's native language, and English if their English level is B2 or higher and they feel comfortable with teaching two languages.
- Giving a presentation of the volunteer's native country with the aim to teach the children its history, culture, customs and traditions.
- Organizing and together with children taking part in some sport activities, strategic games, shows and handcrafts.
- Making intercultural and educational workshops of different kinds: handcrafts, sports, national games, music, dance, photography, etc.

Free time

Free time for volunteers is flexible. The volunteers are mostly busy in the morning having lessons. There's fixed rest hour from 1 to 3 pm. The rest of the day is

flexible and free hours depend on the day's schedule and other volunteers' schedule. You have to keep in mind that the kids will always be around, asking questions and just trying to communicate or play with you. During the camp you will have an opportunity to visit Yoshkar-Ola (the capital of the Mari Republic) and also we are ready to give you a tour around Cheboksary at the end of the camp.

Project:

The project aim is to support rural tourism and entrepreneurship of elderly people in a rural area. The voluntary camp targets to help 2 old ladies to promote their local museum of traditional rural household and to clean touristic routes. The collection of the museum reflects arts of traditional Russian life, local costumes, habits and handcrafts. Volunteers will learn a lot about the way of life in Russian village and its ethnographical heritage.

Work:

Group of international volunteers will clean the territory of the museum, such as cutting bushes, weeds, cleaning the area from rubbish, digging holes in the ground, maintain the terrace of the area. The study part of the voluntary activities will be learning to use materials typical for the local area, such as clay, stones and straw. Volunteers will learn to make lath fences from wands. They will participate on the excursions on the local area and in the city Voronezh and they will get knowledge of local ethnography and history. In the free time volunteers can pick up berries and healthy herbs in local fields and forests.

Location:

30 km away from the city Voronezh (1 mio inhabitants) in a village Tchudovka (for google maps: Voronezhskaya oblast', Semilukskiy rayon).

Accommodation:

in tents on the area of the museum. Shower is heated from the sun. 10 min walk from the area there is a lake, where volunteers can swim. Banyas - the Russian type of sauna - is available.

**Project:**

Zadonsk monastery is one of the well-known monasteries in Russia. Very often this monastery called Russian Jerusalem because of a lot of pilgrims, who come here for blessing and finding answers for their questions. Everyone, who gets in this place, always say that it's incredible fillings to be here. In this monastery lives very kind and open-minded nun Arsenia (she speaks English fluently and likes traveling), she took as her service to care about outcast\homeless animals (mostly are cats) and finding for them new owners.

**Work:**

Volunteers are invited to complete some manual work and some seasonal agricultural work for the monastery. Additionally they will help nun Arsenia (a person who takes care about animals) daily to take care the pets starting from bathing/showering, feeding, health checking the kitties and puppies. Also volunteer will help in searching new owners and building a special place for animals - an animal shelter. Volunteers work 5-6 hours per day.

**Location:**

Zadonsk is a unique place where you can find different attractions. Architecture keeps its charm from 18th century. There is a river Don passing through the town. Zadonsk, Lipetsk region, is a small town, which located on the left bank of the Don River, from which it takes its name (literally, "over-the-Don"). Zadonsk is situated in natural beauty spot and has copious cultural heritage, so it is the best place for finding peace of mind. There are a lot of sites that will show you the real Russian heartland: city Elets (architecture of 17-18 centuries), recreation centers, where you can play sports and try «rope town», as well as a landscaped park and the "City of Masters".

Zadonsk is situated 60 km from Lipetsk, 79 km from Voronezh. Nearest airport is Voronezh or Moscow.

**Accommodation:**

The volunteers will stay in the guest rooms of the Zadonsky monastery. Showers and toilets provided.

**Food:**

Basic food will be provided from the monastery canteen.

**Leisure:**

You can have sportive leisure, such as ropes and climbing area. There are a lot of museums, pottery workshops, you can also plunge in real holy spring or swim in Don river and enjoy nature. Excursions and day trips will be organized to Yelets, Voronezh and safari park, a touristic attraction to see traditional handcrafts, an open air zoo and an open air zone hanging track.

**Special requirements:**

Volunteers have to respect timetable and rules of the orthodox monastery and they have to like animals. Drinking and smoking is forbidden, loud voices and parties are not welcomed at the place. Female and male volunteers will live separately even if they live as a couple.

Summer school for BUDDIES is a project for active students from student services and volunteers in international sphere. Participants of the summer school will exchange best practices of their student services from different countries. They will take part in workshops. Peer-to-peer learning process will be organized with methods of non-formal education: games, creative tasks and case studies. The summer school will include participants from all over the world. Voronezh State University is the hosting partner, it provides trainers and facilitators.

Work:

Volunteers, who attend to join the activity, will have duties to help the organizers of the event with logistics, registration, cleaning, preparing meals etc. Additionally, there will be some manual work in the garden and in the hosting center: remove woods, repair some parts of the house, of the gates and make some outdoor and indoor decorations. Location:

The project will run in the most beautiful place of the Black Earth region of European Russia ¿ in the Open-air museum and natural preserve Divnogorye [www.divnogor.ru](http://www.divnogor.ru) (which can be translated as Wonder Mountains). This place is surrounded by villages, the next big city (84 000 inhabitants) named Liski. It takes 30 min by train or 1 hour by bus to reach it. A night train from Moscow brings volunteers directly to Liski. Meeting places for volunteers: Moscow and Liski.

Accommodation:

Volunteers will live in tents. Water for shower will be heated from the sun, the river is 15 min walk from the host house, toilets are very simple (of the latrine type). Drinking water will be taken from a dwell. There will be 2 local camp leaders, who will support volunteers with practical issues. On weekends volunteers will go sightseeing.

In case of bad weather there is an opportunity to use the neighbours house. Tents and mattresses provided. It is important that you bring warm clothes and warm sleeping bag, especially for night. Banya - Russian type of sauna ¿ is available.

Food:

Volunteers will have meals in the canteen nearby.

The camp is organized by Smolensk regional public youth organization "Rassvet-S" on the base of a rehabilitation center for children and youth Cherry. The center was opened in 1981 as a children's health-improving camp. Since 2006 it became a rehabilitation centre for children. Every year the center hosts about 3000 children. The children come there for rehabilitation for different periods from 3 weeks till half a year. There are children with different kinds of disabilities: with infantile cerebral paralysis and other physical and mental disabilities.

The center is located in a very picturesque place in Smolensk city. Smolensk is one of the most ancient Russian towns. The first mention about this town was in 863. Then it was a very big city with many inhabitants and it had a great influence on Russian politics. In 14th century the town was under the influence of Lithuania and the first half of the 17th century it belonged to Poland. Just in 1654 Smolensk was returned to Russia. Nowadays it is a town with 350,000 inhabitants. It is located at the bank of the Dnepr River about 370 km from Moscow. The city has a lot of historical, architectural and cultural sights. The most interesting sight is of course Smolensk Kremlin that was built in the 16th century. On the Kremlin walls you can visit some museums, including the Thunder museum and the Museum of Russian vodka. Also Smolensk is one of the towns where you can see some very old churches of the 11th- 12th centuries.

Work: Volunteers will be asked to do variety of social activities for the children:

- Volunteers are expected to help to organize the entertaining activities and sport games for the children. Also volunteers will help tutors in the activities orientated to the social rehabilitation of disabled children: games, painting together, organizing workshops.

**Description of Workcamp:** W4U-07 Solovki Botanical Garden (Solovetsky Archipelago), 19 July - 3 August 2015, ENVI, 12 international vols; age 18+

Language: English

Partner: This project is organized in cooperation with Solovki State Historical and Architectural Museum-Reserve which is well-known due to Solovetsky Monastery. Since 15th century Solovetsky Archipelago with its monastery was a religious citadel in the Russian North before being closed by Soviet government in 1920 and turned into a special Soviet prison and labour camp (1926-1939), the Gulag, - for some people the site still reminds this horrible period in USSR history, as a symbol of Stalin's repressions.

The Monastery started to function again in 1990 after 70 years of absence (it was closed by Soviet government in 1920 and turned into a labour prison). The museum buildings and quarters are into consideration to be officially belonged to the church. The island is now in renovation, with the idea to rebuild a religious citadel of the archipelago, and build the infrastructure for the tourists to make the visit of the islands more reachable. For that purposes monastery wishes to move the local population to the mainland, while big part of locals wishes to stay and live in the islands.

Currently, due to the lack of human recourses in the local community, there is a need in volunteers to support the garden as a historical heritage. The volunteers will help to support sustainable maintenance of the garden. Besides, presence of international volunteers brings to local authorities and monastery workers awareness concerning issues of local population.

Location: Solovetsky Islands are an archipelago located in Onega Bay of the White Sea less then 100 miles south of the Arctic Circle. This site is unique from various perspectives: environmental, historical, cultural and social point of view. Project takes place in Botanical Garden, which is situated on a biggest island of Solovetsky Archipelago. This remarkable garden was created in the 19th century as an environmental experiment: to cultivate varieties of plants which originally do not belong to this climate area located close to the Arctic Circle. The Garden is currently well-known of its unique variety of plants (in 2004 there were listed 147 species, forms and varieties of trees and shrubs and 255 herbaceous plants). Some of the scientists who were among the prisoners of the Gulag were put to work on acclimatization in the garden, but many of them never returned to the mainland.

Work: environmental work in the garden. Volunteers will have different tasks such as: harvesting, taking care of plants, digging ditches, trimming trees and bushes.

Accommodation: Volunteers will live in tents in a well-equipped camping of the garden. Food will be provided; volunteers will cook by themselves as a group.

Leisure time: Solovetsky Islands is a pearl of Barents Region. This project is an opportunity for volunteers to learn a lot about Russian culture and history, especially concerning Soviet period. During the free time volunteers will have a chance to visit museum, churches and many monasteries situated in the island.

Special remarks: Volunteers are going to live on the territory of Botanical Garden at the campsite. There you'll need some regular clothes for work and rest. But as soon as we decide to have an excursion and visit some monastery or church you will have to follow the rules of the place. - Girls should wear long skirts, which should cover their knees. Their heads should be also covered by kerchief or something like this. Also your arms should be covered with long sleeves. - Boys shouldn't wear T-shirts and shorts in the monastery, their legs and arms should be covered. They don't have to cover their head while visiting church.
