### The project

'Centre Couleurs du Monde' is a refugee centre of the Belgian Red Cross. At a time it can host up to 190 people who asked for asylum or permanent authorization of residency in Belgium. Their stay in the centre is temporary and lasts until the necessary documents to stay legally in this country are ready and their refugee status is proved. The centre provides services such as accommodation, food, medical and social support, cultural, sport events, educational courses, etc.

The project in Centre Couleur du Monde is built on the dynamic meeting between the international volunteers and the residents of the centre. It is especially expected that both will learn from each other and will conjointly participate in artistic and cultural activities.

The project 2014 will be the 6th in the history of the Centre. Previous years were successful and were a source of an enthusiasm to go on.

### Work

A mix of artistic creation and animation with the youngest refugees (6 to 12 years old). In the morning, the volunteers will decorate the walls of the center in a way that they will have to build together. In the afternoon, they will prepare activities for the children of the centre (handicraft, sport, games...).

### Accommodation

Accommodation will be provided in the Centre itself - 2 rooms per 4 volunteers each. Every room has its own bathroom and toilet, but still very simple. The rooms are exactly the same as residents' ones; but can be provided if there is enough space for people who asked for asylum, who have a priority for accommodation. Smoking and alcohol drinking inside is strictly forbidden.

### Food

Food will be provided, relax - no cooking! - due to the fact that diet of refugees doesn't allow it, you won't eat pork during your stay. If you keep a vegetarian diet - you are welcome as well, just let us know.

### Location

Rendeux is a countryside village that lies in the country's Walloon Region and

Luxembourg Province and accounts up to 2,500 inhabitants. The village of Rendeux is situated in the valley of the River Ourthe in an area, which attracts many visitors both for its natural beauty and for such nearby medieval villages as La Roche-en-Ardenne (11km) and Durbuy (18km). #### Project

Compagnons Bâtisseurs Belgium (CBB) directly hosts this project which is part of its permanent programme 'Volunteering, Entertainment and Disability'.

The aim of the camp is to offer to people with learning difficulties (light mental handicap) the possibility to go on holidays with young international volunteers. During the workcamp, they will share leisure time activities, make cultural visits and, above all, have fun. Thanks to this stay, the people with disability find a new space for socialization, out of their family and usual daily life environment. They can also enjoy activities they do not use to take part in. For the volunteers, it is also a very good opportunity to gain awareness about handicap and the abilities of people with disability.

There will be 14 persons with disability and 10 'volunteers-animators' in the camp. The disabled people are between 18 and 50 year old.

#### Work

During these days, international volunteers, Belgian volunteers, CBB staff and people in situation of disability will spend together 24 hours a day.

The role expected from the volunteers is a role of active animators. They will propose and lead activities such as outdoor or indoor games, artistic workshops or cultural visits. They will also support the people who suffer a lack of autonomy in tasks such as cleaning the place, preparing the meals, washing and/or dressing themselves.

A professional leader and experienced Belgian volunteers will be present all along the project and accompany the international volunteers in their tasks.

2 days of preparation, between volunteers, are foreseen before that the holidays start.

#### Accommodation

Except for the two days of preparation, we will share a cottage. We will have several dormitories and all the modern facilities, but you will need to bring your sleeping bag and your pillow.

#### Food

Self-catering. Meals will depend on your cookery talents.

#### Location

In a house in Chevetogne's domain. Chevetogne is located at the South of Belgium between Dinant and Rochefort. Many activities are possible in this very green part of the country. While waiting for the documents that will enable them to remain legally in our country, the immigrants are accommodated in this centre in the Brussels vicinity.

People living there await the solution concerning their administrative status. They never know what tomorrow may bring to them. There is a possibility that they will not obtain the authorisation to remain in Belgium and will have to leave the country. But on the other hand, they might see their dreams come true and get the chance to take a new start in life.

Therefore, residents often found themselves overwhelmed by feelings of relief and anguish, hope and disappointment. The life of Rixensart Refugees Centre reflects these individual dramas and big international tensions. Refugees often come with their children, who attend the school in the village in order to help their integration in Belgium.

### Work

#### The project

The aim of this camp is to offer to people with light mental handicap the possibility to go on holidays with young international volunteers.
