PROJECT: The Friends of William Clarke Park is a not-for-profit community organisation with a mission to improve a small green space (also known as 'The Patch') situated in Brighton. They are dedicated to making the space a cleaner and safer environment for all local people to enjoy and to create events to bring the community together. Every year the Friends of William Clarke Park put on a summer community festival and this year they are looking to invite volunteers to help!

WORK: The volunteers will be involved in helping to set up the festival site; this will include constructing marquees, staging, site decoration and signage. The community festival will be taking place on the 13th July and volunteers will be needed to help and supervise various activities eg. Tea tent, stewarding the bouncy castle, youth music stage etc. as well as providing support and assisting whenever needed. Volunteers will also need to help with the clearing up and taking down of the site at the end of the festival.

ACCOMMODATION & FOOD: Volunteers will be sleeping on site in marquees and tents. There will be basic cooking facilities, a fridge, electricity, water, etc for the volunteers to prepare food. Toilets and shower facilities will be onsite. Since it is always nice to try new and different dishes, volunteers are encouraged to bring along their favourite recipes from home!

PROJECT: The One World Festival is a magical holistic health summer event, that promotes and teaches healthy lifestyles and macrobiotic food. Individuals and families come together to share one or two weeks in a unique atmosphere focusing on workshops and lectures on a range of therapies, natural movement and dance forms, exercise for physical and spiritual development, holistic health, arts, crafts and sports, as well as specialist areas such as natural cookery. There is also a separate activity programme for teenagers and children. Around 850 people are expected to take part in the festival.

WORK: The international volunteers will make up a team of 100 volunteers helping set up and run the festival. They will be assisting with workshops, supervising children, stewarding, assisting with security and also TAKING DOWN THE FESTIVAL at the end of the project. Volunteers will work for around 6 hours a day and will work in pairs or small groups at different times on shift patterns depending on the work requirements. During free time volunteers will be able to take part in workshops or activities of their choice or simply enjoy the beautiful countryside.

ACCOMMODATION & FOOD: In tents on site, with toilet and shower facilities provided. Volunteers must bring sleeping bags and roll mats. Three healthy meals a day will be provided which will be mostly organic vegetarian, vegan or macrobiotic. Please note there will be no meat, fish or dairy in the food available.

LOCATION: Deep in the heart of the cotswolds, Croft Farm is a holiday park located just outside Tewkesbury on the scenic River Avon Valley. Set in 60 acres of glorious English countryside, featuring a beautiful lake, with a real holiday feeling. Croft farm is a large area of natural beauty, run by like minded hosts.

PROJECT: Concordia is happy to be working again with the community of Midhurst. The festival brings together all the creative, artistic & musical talent that is in the wonderful town of Midhurst in the heart of the South Downs.

A ten day series of events, from all genres of the arts involving community groups, charities, societies, individuals, businesses & venues celebrating & developing all that is great in the community, culminating in a carnival procession & musical theatre spectacular.

WORK: The volunteers will be involved in doing art and design projects for the main carnival parade and main events. Volunteers will have access to a local leisure centre where they will be able to shower. Please note you will be outside for the majority of the time so bring clothes that will be suitable for wet weather as well as dry.

Work: The volunteers will be working in the fields and polytunnels. They will be sowing, planting, weeding and harvesting vegetables and salads. They will also be involved in the construction of a shelter in the field which will be used for accommodation and a cob oven. They will also take part in landscaping around the polytunnels. The working hours will be between 8am and 5pm and this will take place at Caerhys farm in the field, polytunnels and a share shed. The volunteers will learn and develop skills in the growing of organic vegetables and salads in a sustainable way as part of a community initiative.

Accommodation: Volunteers will stay in two static caravans (accommodating six volunteers) with others staying in tents. These will be located on site and the volunteers will need to bring sleeping bags. There is a barn area for communal activities.

Location: Caerhys is located in Pembrokeshire, a beautiful national park area situated on the coast of West Wales. Although this project is remote, the nearest city of St David's (the smallest city in the UK) is four miles away and buses to the city run around four times a day during the peak season. There are lots of activities available in this area including walking the Welsh Coastal path, water sports such as kayaking, surfing and coastering, as well as rock climbing and fishing. Despite being small the area is a very popular tourist destination thanks to its natural beauty and vibrant culture.

Special Requirements: Volunteers need to bring work boots, work gloves, warm and waterproof clothing and sleeping bags.

Work: The Green Valley was started in 2008 by local people, who supported by Bryncynon Strategy, wanted to create a place for the local community to learn about the environment and wildlife conservation. At the Green Valley Centre, a range of activities are provided allowing people to learn about their local environment, participate in growing and other leisure related activities. The Workcamp volunteers, working in small groups, will undertake the following activities: Annual maintenance of a Bio-diversity Wetland Area; Construction of a Permaculture Growing Polytunnel; Installation of a Rain-water Harvesting Irrigation System; and various Horticultural related tasks upon the Green Valley site. The working hours will be Monday to Friday from 9.30 am to 4 pm.

Accommodation: The group will stay in Community Hall, 1.5 kilometres from the green Valley Centre. There will be a minibus transport provided to the site every day. Volunteers will sleep in separate male and female areas. There is a kitchen and volunteers will be able to shower in a local sports centre.

Location: Abercynon is centrally located with the Valleys Region of South Wales, where a wide range of places of interest are in easy reach. This includes: visiting sites of historic significance in the former mining area of the Valleys, as well as castles and the Museum of Welsh life. Access to the seashore is never far away, as well as the Brecon Beacons, Gower Peninsular and Pembrokeshire National Park. Cardiff, the Capital City of Wales is easy to get to by road and train, with good cultural activities, shopping facilities and night-life. Additionally, the rural heartland of Wales is close by, which offers scenic countryside access, mountains, lakes, waterfalls and rural wilderness.

Special Requirements: Sleeping bag and mat, waterproof clothing and strong footwear.
