Centre Couleurs du Monde is a reception centre for asylum seekers managed by Belgian Red Cross. It can host up to 200 people who have asked for asylum in Belgium. Their stay in the centre is temporary and lasts until a decision is taken regarding a possible refugee status.

The centre provides such services as accommodation, food, medical and social counselling, schooling and educational courses, cultural, sport events etc.

One of the most important points is that the centre is open to the world, by promoting international exchanges with volunteers from all over the world. That is the main purpose of the camp intercultural exchanges thanks to a voluntary project.

The village of Rendeux is located in the valley of the River Ourthe in an area which attracts many visitors both for its natural beauty and for such nearby medieval villages as La Roche-en-Ardenne (11km) and Durbuy (18km). The aim of this camp is to offer to people with light mental disability the possibility to go on holidays with young international volunteers. During the workcamp, they share leisure time activities, make cultural visits and, above all, have fun. Thanks to this stay, people with learning disabilities can leave their parents, their daily life, and spend time with other adults of their age. They wouldn't be able to go on holiday alone. Volunteers and the CBB staff will accompany them in their leisure time and help them with their daily tasks. There will be 12 people with learning disabilities, 8 volunteers and one group leader. The disabled people are between 18 and 50 year old.

Work:

The two 1st days will be dedicated to prepare the activities and the schedule of the project (the people with learning disabilities will arrive the 22th of July). From the 22th, volunteers, CBB staff and disabled people will spend together 24 hours a day. The CBB staff and the volunteers will in charge to organise the leisure time (excursions, walks, games, parties, etc.), daily life and the meals. During the project, each volunteer will be responsible to care and facilitate an active participation of one or two person with learning disabilities.

The Marche-en-Famenne workcamp is the outcome of the collaboration between municipal authorities and a local non-profit organization. More than fifteen years ago, the mayor and deputies wanted to develop international contacts for the local youngsters. GRIMM association was just beginning to work on the protection of the local life framework and promoting models of sustainable development. Since then, the municipality makes its buildings available every summer and welcomes foreign youngsters. GRIMM members organize the work. And if each of us may enjoy it, it has to be protected.

Assisted by local technical leaders, the volunteer group will realize different manual tasks outside and take care of other places built during previous workcamps a barbecue area, benches, shelter. If you like working with wood this is your workcamp!

A big BBQ will be organized at the beginning and at the end of the camp.
