For the second time, a workcamp will take place in Winterlingen, a community in the German region Baden-Wuerttemberg. Winterlingen is situated in the Swabian Alb, between Stuttgart and Lake Constance. The community has around 6400 inhabitants, the next town Albstadt is only 10km away. The project consists of many different tasks in Winterlingen and the nearby nature reserve. Workers of the local building yard will instruct and support the work. You will do painting works at different places, like the graveyard wall in Winterlingen, in the sports hall and in local Kindergartens. Another task will be the paving of the so called "Winkele-Wege", small paths connecting the main roads. Besides you will do different works in the nature and green areas in and around Winterlingen. You will be accommodated in the newly renovated "Kaplaneihaus". The house has four shared rooms (max.6 people) and three double rooms. Each room has its own bathroom. A big common room and a well-equipped kitchen are also provided. Every morning a bus shuttle will take you to your working place. Winterlingen is situated in the nature reserve "Obere Donau", offering beautiful hiking trails and various castles to visit. The community has a good infrastructure with shopping possibilities, sports facilities and the biggest natural outdoor pool of Baden-Wuerttemberg. On the weekends you can visit the university town Tübingen, Stuttgart or spend a day near Lake Constance.

Description of Workcamp:

The community tries to arrange bicycles for the workcamp, so you should be able to ride a bike. Ability to swim is highly recommended. It will be the 5th time that the International Street-Art-Festival takes place in Blumberg and the first time that it will be supported by an international workcamp. It is now one of the three big Festivals for Street or Pavement painters in Germany. In the last years artists from Italy, Spain, Hungary, Argentina, Venezuela, Belgium, Austria, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Russia, Ukraine and Croatia performed on the streets of Blumberg. This unique event is a nice mixture of charismatic artworks by professionals as well as amateurs, and a framework program that accompanies this family friendly festival. The festival itself will be on the 9th & 10th of July. Website of the festival: <http://www.street-art-festival.de/index.php/media.html>. Another part of the project will be open-air cinema nights (16th & 17th) in the newly re-opened public swimming pool. In addition to these events, the workcamp will support the community with renovating playgrounds. You will help the organizers in all phases of the festival: building up the infrastructure beforehand, taking care of the artists during the event, helping at the entrance and help with the disassembly at the end.

You will also help running the open-air cinema event that is part of the celebrations for the newly re-opened swimming pool, called "Panoramabad". In addition to working at these events, you will help the community with renovation tasks on the local playgrounds. You will live in the community building „Gemeinschaftshaus Zollhaus“, which is located in a small part of Blumberg around 3 km from the center. Toilets, a kitchen and a nice outdoor area are available. You will have free access to the „Panoramabad“, where you can use the showers. Please bring your own sleeping bags! Blumberg is located in the southern part of the Black Forrest close to Switzerland. Around 10.000 inhabitants are spread over 9 parts and villages, which all belong to Blumberg. Blumberg is famous for hikers, because it is close to the "Wutachschlucht", a spectacular gorge and nature reserve. Another Highlight is the historic, steam powered Railway called „Sauschwaenzlebahn“. Several other touristic places are quite close, like the Rhine waterfalls in Switzerland or the Island Mainau in the lake "Bodensee".

Our partners in this project are the scouts of the tribe "Schwarzer Mustang Achentel" (Black Mustang Achentel). In 2014 the community gave them the compound of a former tavern as their new club house. It is located remotely in the middle of the nature, but only a few minutes from the village centre. They have already invested hundreds of working hours into their new home, called "Foxbau", but there is still a lot to do and they are very happy to welcome international volunteers to help them. There are a lot of projects planned on the compound: Rebuilding the path around the lake and constructing a small bridge over the creek that flows into the lake, Construction of terraces for a camping ground, Demolition of small sheds, Construction of a new storage for fire wood, Building an outdoor shower, Renovation works on one of the terraces, Painting the roof, Beautifying the garden and the building, some outdoor tasks along the small creek and maybe even building a pizza oven. The local host requires a motivation letter. Please also be aware that in this workcamp, only volunteers between 18 and 30 years will be accepted! Every year during the school holidays, the community of Weissach organises a summer camp for children aged 6 - 14. After last year's success and great cooperation, they are looking forward to interacting with international volunteers for the 6th time. There will be German professional educators and 8 international volunteers as leaders of the summer camp. Specific tasks will be attending to and looking after the kids and youngsters during different activities, such as: excursions, games and campfire - a typical summer camp! In the beginning of the camp, all leaders will help set up the camp site and plan activities. Two leaders (one international, one German) will be in charge of a group of 15 kids. The centre of the camp will be a big circus tent which will host different activities. So, if you like spending time with an international group and children, if you like to be asked a lot of (German) questions, and if you love to provide an outlet for the curiosity of children – you are the perfect participant for this camp! Welcome to Weissach! Working hours will be long but very rewarding and you will spend your free time mostly together with the kids (going on a trip with the kids on the weekend for example)! Some knowledge of the German language would be helpful but isn't obligatory! Your days off will not be during weekends. The host will organise free time activities! In the beginning, the group will be introduced to the project and have the chance to experience some major team-building activities so that all leaders can smoothly work together and make the stay worthwhile. The first few days, while the camp is being set up, the international group will stay in a school building, where all sanitary facilities are provided. During the summer camp, all leaders and kids will stay in tents on the camp site. Although the workcamp will take place during summer months, be aware that the nights can be very cold. Please bring a warm sleeping bag, a thick sleeping mat and rainwear! All facilities will be available. Food will be served. Weissach is a village with around 7000 inhabitants who are very active and dedicated to the project. It is located close to Stuttgart, the state-capital of Baden-Wurtemberg, but also has a lot of nature to experience and enjoy after work or on the weekends. After the great success with its first workcamp in 2013, the team for children and youth work (Team Kinder- und Jugendarbeit) in Erlensee (in short TKJE) is going to host another international work camp in the summer of 2016. The youth center offers a wide range of activities for kids between 6 and 18 years: leisure and cultural activities, social work in order to support children in need and special events with various topics. Region: Erlensee is a town with a population of approx. 13,000 in the German federal state of Hessen. It is situated 25 km in the east of the international city Frankfurt on the Main. Erlensee consists of two boroughs, Ruckingen and Langendiebach, and apart from minor shopping possibilities, it is a rather rural area. However, Hanau, the closest bigger town (Pop.: about 90,000), is only 7 km away and easy to reach by bike or bus. Hanau once was a prosperous city, because local sovereigns once welcomed the Huguenot, refugees from France to settle in their dominion and supported them to perform their knowledge in handcraft and trade. International volunteers are invited to support youth work of this center: In the first week, there will be manual work to do. In the center of Erlensee will be created a new skate place for teenagers and the youth, for skaters, bikers, graffiti-artists and everyone who is interested to use this public space. Together we want to build an interesting place, which invites to meet all these different kind of people. In the second week, the summer camp for children aged 6 to 12 takes place. With your help, this playscheme will be an international experience for the local kids. Your task will include caring for the children and designing the week s program together with our team of volunteers. The summer camp starts in the morning and ends in the late afternoon. One of the program points is the collective cooking for lunch and we are looking forward to your contribution with international recipes. We will also welcome your propositions for our creative, artistic and sportive activities. Study part: Getting to know concepts of youth work, diversity of subcultures of youth in Germany. The participants will be housed in the local sports centre. Several sleeping rooms, bathrooms, a shower and a big kitchen where you can cook and eat together will be at your disposal. Description of Workcamp:

Please bring a sleeping bag with you. The camp takes place at the Mullerhof , which is a reconstructed traditional half-timbered farmhouse near the cities of Dresden, Chemnitz and Leipzig. It runs a socio-cultural center of the local community and has constructed a so-called garden of senses which consists of a small park, a play area, trees for climbing and a natural stage for events with an 80 year old circus-wagon. It also has an area with herbal garden and berry bushes. Region: Mittweida is surrounded by a nice landscape with nice places waiting to be visited. Next interesting cities are Freiberg, Leipzig, Dresden. There is a university for applied science with lots of international students. Important is the work in the Garten der Sinne , which needs maintenance every year. Especially the tunnels made of wicker. This year a nice place for recreation and socializing will be completed in the garden. This means refilling the spot with mould and designing as lovely landscape. In case of rainy weather there is renovation to do indoors. Volunteers will be integrated into the household and are asked to cook the typical food of our country for approximately 20 guests and staff of the Mullerhof. In the end of the workcamp an international evening is planned, to introduce the countries of the participants. This will be open to the public. Study part: We can explore the possibilities and activities of the Mullerhof as an example of an socio cultural center. It will be possible to join workshops. In the last years volunteers joined for example yoga classes. The participants will sleep in the big loft of the Muellerhof (80m) which includes a shower and toilets. There is a range of possibilities for excursions and visits of interesting places: Guided tour through the University of Applied Sciences, visits to the town hall, museum and church of Mittweida. We will also offer outdoor activities and guided hiking-tours in the area (e.g. a hike to a dam, the fortress Kriebstein or the Rochlitzer Porphyberg). It s also possible to visit the cities nearby (Dresden, Leipzig or Chemnitz). Please bring a sleeping bag with you. Thee will be only one big room for the group to sleep.

Description of Workcamp:

Please bring solid shoes and work clothes, sleeping bag and sleeping pads. The association KLOSTERGUT e.V. has set itself the task of preserving the historic buildings and the park areas of the former convent and to establish an educational learning center about organic farming. The History: The convent Heiningen was founded around the year 1000 as a home for nuns, called Kanonissenstift. It was equipped with rich land by the local sovereigns and was confirmed by a document from Emperor Henry II at 1013. Today a monastery church of Romanesque style from the year 1200 can still be found. Around 1350 the plague killed many people and made many rural residents to move to the cities. Entire villages were abandoned and many agricultural lands laid fallow. There was a short period of prosperity, when the nuns could sing and pray and their embroidered carpets were famous even in foreign countries. Then the monastery in 1542 was plundered by Saxon soldiers and reformed against the will of the residents. Since more than 100 years the estate is secularized, while the church was separated from the manor. Nevertheless, the buildings still exist as an architectural ensemble. The present inhabitants run an Organic Farm with particularly emphasis on dairy cattle with an attached creamery and a farm shop for organic food. About 40 Cows and 40 calves, 12 lively pigs, several cats and one dog can be met on the site.

Environment: The monastery Heiningen is located in the northern mountains of Harz at Lower Saxony. The region is primarily characterized by rural character and its agricultural use. It is surrounded by glacial ridges and in the south one can see the shape of the Harz, a famous low mountain range. As part of the national cultural heritage of Germany one can find artefacts from the area of prehistoric human history, medieval monasteries, castles and medieval towns. In Goslar, situated around 30 km in the south you can find three sites which are declared as UNESCO World Heritage: Goslar's Old Town, the medieval silver mine Rammelsberg and Upper Harz Water Management. Within a radius of 25 km there are the cities of Braunschweig, Wolfenbuttel and Salzgitter. We are looking for 12 motivated young people who are keen on craft work, landscaping and interest in dealing with farm animals. You are invited to maintain the (green) open space and paths and renovate the historic buildings and beautify the area. Work for the designing and construction of the planned educational learning center about organic farming, preparatory work for growing vegetables and small livestock will be running.

Study: We are living in a time with industrial agriculture which provokes lots of problems in the environment. Participants will learn about regional organic farming and how it can be sustainable and environmentally friendly. You can explore special features of ecological agriculture: in particular, the production of milk and cheese. Accommodation will be offered in large dormitories, Food will be prepared together in a big kitchen. Trips to the Region (Harz, Goslar, Braunschweig), sightseeing, swimming. The monastery complex itself offers creative possibilities for leisure activities. Please bring solid shoes and work clothes, sleeping bag and sleeping pads.

Since many years now, the City Hall of Prenzlau is hosting successful workcamps. Prenzlau is the capital of one of the biggest counties in Germany. The historical name of this landscape is Uckermark. The town is located approximately 100km north of the national capital Berlin, 50 km from Stettin in Poland and 80 km from the Baltic Sea. The area is surrounded by natural parks (for example Biosphere Reserve Schorfheide-Chorin) and large lakes. At the promenade of the Lake Unteruckersee you can find the boathouse (Bootshaus) of the local rowing and canoeing club. Wukania Projektehof is a community, where people work and live together. In the time of the GDR (German Democratic Republik), the compound was a college of physical education with lots of facilities to train various kind of sport. Situated on the lake Wukensee, it is part of the resort of the little town Biesenthal (approx. 5500 citizen). The region is a protected area, called Nature park Barnim. In the project of Wukania, people come together to practice a self-determined and sustainable lifestyle. There are lots of different projects already existing: Two housing projects, an outdoor kindergarten, facilities for groups running a seminar, a place for camping including outdoor facilities like solar showers and composting toilet, an outdoor kitchen and some little gardens. Some people are working in the workshops for wood and metal. A few horses and chicken are also living in the yard. There are many plans for the future: another housing project with facilities for people who needs care will be build, a flat for refugees will be offered and a collective will work as catering service for schools and kindergarten in the region. It is important to know that Wukania is kind of living example for a human utopia: Houses, facilities, projects are self - organized, decisions are made in the spirit of consensus. Inhabitants like to learn from each other and to support each other. Wukania wants to work and live in sustainable manner; buildings are made mostly with loam, heating in the buildings is run with wood, hot water is prepared with solar power, composting toilets help to spare water and give fertilizer. Food is prepared vegetarian or even vegan. Inhabitants show a high commitment in political, social and cultural projects and is well integrated in the region. Examples for diverse cooperation are the Kulturbahnhof in Biesenthal, a shelter for refugees next town and different vegetable farmers. For more information please visit <http://www.wukania.net/> There are different construction sites in the compound of Wukania. Volunteers are invited to help in different kind of renovation work. Every help is welcome, even without certain skills like plastering and painting. But skilled volunteers also can learn how to work with wood like a carpenter, to lay tiles or a wooden floor. As heating is run with wood, firewood can be prepared and stored. There are some more ideas and we will communicate them later. Important part of the work is to prepare food for the group of volunteers and to keep facilities clean. For sure there will be the possibility to find any work in accordance with abilities and interests of the volunteers. Study: Inhabitants of Wukania would like to show you their life style, and would like to discuss certain aspects of a life which is mostly self-determined, self-organized, and community based: Questions like: What s the motivation to join this community? Since 1992 this association has been organizing workcamps. In 1994 a biological-dynamic, social therapeutic nursery was added. The association is running an organic garden. Since 2007 the castle also runs a garden cafe and a small castle museum. During the last 20 years the castle became a sociocultural center for the region: In the castle there is a perfect room for celebrations, around the castle one can find various types of gardens and meadow for goose and goats. In addition there are training courses and cultural activities available. The aim of this project is to create an atmosphere where people with or without disabilities may come, live and work together without any prejudice against handicap, nationality or religion. The website gives an impression about the specific character of this place <http://schloss.bedheim.de>.
