Mondiali Antirazzisti (The Antiracist World Cup) is a multicultural 5 days long festival which has around 7.000 visitors per day. The main idea of the festival is to promote anti-racism and anti-discrimination through non-competitive tournaments of football, volleyball, basketball, touch rugby and cricket. The goal of these sport activities is to get to know each other and have fun together, not to win. More than 200 teams every year join the Mondiali Antirazzisti and 70 of the teams are mixed: no racist or sexist discrimination is allowed. There are many other activities taking place during the festival such as concerts, workshops, debates, summer camp for children. The organisers take care of another important aspect of the event which is low environmental impact, reached thanks to recycling, use of renewable resources and natural local products. For the people of Mondiali Antirazzisti the environmental sustainability is linked to the social justice and equality. Please make sure you share these values before applying for this project. Website: www.mondialiantirazzisti.org (English version is available). The international volunteers will be part of a bigger team of volunteers helping set up, run and take down the festival. Before the festival the group of the international volunteers will help to construct the marquees, decorate the area, put up signage etc. Typical activities during the festival include cleaning the site and helping with waste sorting, however the past years volunteers have been involved in a number of different activities, according to the festival needs. The volunteers will clean up and take down the site at the end of the festival. The international volunteers will work for around 6/7 hours per day. The work will be done in pairs or small groups in different shifts (to be arranged together with the camp leader). Please note that flexibility and adaptability are required, and there might be some physically demanding work from time to time (under the sun or rain sometimes). During the free time the volunteers will have the opportunity to join concerts and sport events in the festival area. International volunteers will have 2 free days, to be arranged with the festival organisers (not during the 5 days of the festival, from 6th to 10th of July). Volunteers will sleep in shared big tents directly at the festival area. Toilet and washing facilities will be available, camp beds will be provided but you must bring a sleeping bag. Please make sure you are comfortable with basic camping conditions. Food will be available at the restaurants/bars of the festival area. There will be no opportunity to cook but different options (vegetarian, vegan, dietary needs) could be available. The volunteers are expected to be flexible and not fussy about the food. Bosco Albergati is a suburb of Castelfranco Emilia, a small town of 30.000 inhabitants in the province of Modena. The festival area and accommodation are situated in the countryside and are quite isolated from the city. Castelfranco Emilia lies about 25 kilometres northwest of Bologna. The nearest airport is Marconi International Airport in Bologna. You may consider other airports in the area, such as Rimini and Parma. To reach Castelfranco Emilia you will need to catch a train from BOLOGNA. More information will be provided in the infosheet. A project-related motivation letter is required.

Project-related motivation letter is required. We don't need people with specific curriculum but aware about the topic and really motivated to contribute to the project. Any qualification or previous experience as nurse, physiotherapist or educator etc. is very welcome. Rio de Oro is a non profit association whose aim is to provide medical care and assistance to Saharawi people, especially kids with different kinds of disabilities (physical, cognitive, mental, sensory, emotional, developmental). Saharawi (desert people) are living in refugee camps in the southwest of Algeria. The Saharawi refugees have survived the great exodus from the Western Sahara: endless marches in the desert in 1975. Rio de Oro was established in 2000 and helps Saharawi people with handicap problems directly in Algeria and in Italy. The main activities of Rio de Oro are: distance support for disabled, support to the schools of special education, health care in refugee camps, experimental gardening in the desert, welcome summer camps and health care in Italy for disabled children (6-11 years old). Website (only in Italian): <http://www.riodeoro.it/> The international volunteers will be helping the staff and numerous national volunteers work with Saharawi children (6-11 years old) with different kinds of disabilities (physical, cognitive, mental, sensory, emotional, developmental). This means that in most of the cases the kids are not self-sufficient. Daily activities of the international volunteers will include the following: feeding the children (breakfast, lunch, dinner, snacks), getting them dressed, changing the diapers, washing them, helping clean the school, cooking together. But also we need volunteers to come with a lot of energy to play, run and push a wheelchair for races or go to the beach with the children. The shifts during the day and night will be very flexible (to be arranged with the camp leader and with local volunteers) so flexibility and adaptability are strongly required. English will be the working language of the workcamp but any language skills are welcome. Along with English, the main spoken languages in the workcamp usually are: Italian (most of our volunteers are local), Spanish (Western Sahara used to be a Spanish colony before the Moroccan occupation and the leaders that come with the kids are fluent Spanish speakers) and, of course, Hassaniya, the Arabic dialect the kids speak. Nevertheless, don't worry, you will manage to understand the kids, some of them speak fluent Italian and there will be a lot of interpreters to help. The international volunteers will be hosted at the primary school in the city centre along with the national volunteers and the children. The school is equipped with: 5 shared bedrooms that will be appropriately separated for girls and boys, and the kids; bathrooms and a shower for each bedroom; common bathrooms; dining room; kitchen; common areas: two halls for activities; gardens with games around the building; Feldenkrais room for the children physical therapy. Breakfast, lunch and dinner are provided at the canteen by the hosting organization. Grottammare is a really nice seaside town of 15.000 inhabitants on Italy's Adriatic coast, in the province of Ascoli Piceno, Marche region. Nearest airports are ROME (Ciampino or Fiumicino), BOLOGNA and ANCONA. Grottammare bus station is the nearest terminal. Project-related motivation letter is required. We don't need people with

A project-related motivation letter is required. Minimum age 20 y.o. Odoardina is one of the 6 care centres for disabled people managed by the social cooperative named ZORA (<http://www.coopzora.it>). It is a day care centre for people with different kind of disabilities (physical, cognitive, mental, sensory, emotional, developmental). The day care centre provides a range of social services for about 20 people with disabilities (aged 20 to 50 years) from 09 am to 04 pm, from Monday to Friday. The general purpose is to help people with disabilities to live in their communities and to promote independent living, giving the opportunity to develop relational, social life and employment skills in accordance with their individual needs. YAP organizes international workcamps in Odoardina during the summer period since more than 10 years and the international volunteers are really well welcome by the staff and the people of the day care centre. The international volunteers will support the social workers and civic service volunteers in the activities organized for the disabled people: games, workshops and tasks aimed to encourage self expression, communication and interpersonal relationships through singing, music, drawing and painting, beauty salon, handicraft with recycling paper, swimming pool, day-trips and home cleaning. Tregiridite is a non profit association whose aim is to provide medical care and assistance to Saharawi people, especially kids with different kinds of disabilities (physical, cognitive, mental, sensory, emotional, developmental). Saharawi (desert people) are living in refugee camps in the southwest of Algeria. The Saharawi refugees have survived the great exodus from the Western Sahara: endless marches in the desert in 1975. Since 2009 Tregiridite works with a little group of children providing them with medical care in Italy and in the refugee camps. The main activities of Tregiridite are: welcome summer camps and health care in Italy for disabled children (6 - 11 years old), raising awareness events during the summer, support to the medical care of the children, education and animation activities with the children, restoring and gardening of Villaggio Arcobaleno, the centre where the association and its activities are based. Breakfast, lunch and dinner are provided at the canteen by the hosting organization and the volunteers will arrange cooking

and cleaning dishes teams everyday. Villaggio Arcobaleno - Tricase (LE). Tricase is a really nice small town in the province of Lecce, south-east Italy. It is located in the Salento region. Nearest airports are Brindisi and Bari. A project-related motivation letter is required. One part of the castle is now integrated with scattered hotel in Castelluccio, the aim is to make park and the structure available for visitors and guests. Volunteers will be working 7-8 hours per day under the supervision of local technical leader. It s NO possible to visit Rome after work or in the free time. Visit to Rome could be arranged only during the free day. In the past YAP Italy organised several workcamps in Roiate in cooperation with the town hall and an NGO called Sentiero Verde (Green Footpath). Roiate is a small isolated and picturesque village, about 45 km from Rome, surrounded by the natural park of Aniene river. There are some ancient ruins in the park: this territory has been inhabited since the pre-Roman era and you can still observe pieces of polygonal walls (aka Cyclopean masonry) built in the Iron Age. In the Middle Age, Roiate fell under control of the monastery of Subiaco and, according to the legend, Saint Benedict from Norcia left his mark on a stone nearby while lying on it. Ever since the IV century a church and then a convent were built to preserve this stone. The church, devoted to Saint Benedict himself, still exists. Rich natural, cultural and historical heritage ensures the constant interest of pilgrims and hikers in visiting this area thanks to several trekking footpaths across the natural park. Sentiero Verde is a non profit organisation that since 30 years deals with trekking and ecotourism in Lathium region, creates different extra urban and urban footpaths, organises training courses for mountain guides, promotes sustainable tourism and local development of territory through hiking. Thanks to the previous workcamps, Sentiero Verde has already restored a part of footpath of Roiate, it s time to make a next step. Volunteers will be involved in many different outdoor activities such as cleaning and maintenance of the path that leads from the village to the ancient ruins, signals and fences restoring, lands reclaiming, garbage removing. Volunteers will be working 7-8 hours per day under the supervision of local technical leader. Be prepared for physical work. This event was already organized on summer 2013 (26th May i 9th June) when 20 trekkers and 3 international volunteers walked from Ortona to Rome in 15 days during the main project Da Tommaso a Pietro, In Cammino that moved also 20 horse riders, 50 cyclists and 300 pilgrims on the same route and days, obviously with different departures from Ortona. All the participants arrived together in St. Peter Square in Rome where they assisted to the traditional catholic celebration Angelus , during which, they received a particular greeting by Pope Francis. In 2014 and 2015 the walk-event was done in the opposite direction from Rome to Ortona with more than 200 participants arrived in Piazza San Tommaso and volunteers from different countries that walked all the path. The most important result of its actions has been the creation of Garbatella Park which, through a 20-year engagement, has been involving citizens, associations, local administrators and obtained the official custody of the area by the Assessorship to Environment.

Description of Workcamp: Project summary: The workcamp will contribute in the biodiversity and legality safeguard at Vesuvius slopes.

Description

Project: Participants will be mainly involved in the care and maintenance of the ¿Environment and Legality¿ observatory of the Vesuvius National Park (VNP), managed by Legambiente. It is a structure containing among the outdoor spaces, 4 community gardens, a remembrance and civil commitment¿s park (with trees in memory of Mafia¿s victims), 2 indoor classrooms for activities with children and young people. The indoor area is characterized by an intercultural workshop and a projection room. The volunteers will also be engaged in the cleaning and maintenance of the paths of the VNP and in the requalification of the old train station of Boscotrecase managed by Libera and Legambiente. Finally, at the headquarters of Legambiente, they will participate in moments of exchange and social confrontation with the local guys and/or with other people engaged in the defense of common goods with other associations.

Legambiente local group: The voluntary association Legambiente Ottaviano ¿Mimmo Beneventano¿ began its activity of denunciation of the abuses of that area in the early '80s as a local association, and joined Legambiente in 1989. In recent years the association has linked his name to important initiatives to expose illegality's spread on the territory of Vesuvius, managing to achieve important results like the closure of garbage dump of Somma Vesuviana, Herculaneum and Terzigno, located in the National Park, the numerous charges against abusive pits, hydrogeological instability, aquifers and wells¿ pollution, forest fires, illegal building and so on; sometimes denouncing omissions, indifference and inefficiency of local administration.

Moreover, Legambiente is in charge of excursions in the Vesuvius National Park, environmental education, ¿environment and legality¿ help desk, volunteer workcamp and civil protection.

Work: manual agricultural work, social events planning, naturalistic research about flora and fauna, green areas maintenance and monitoring (to prevent hunting, fires or other abuses). Moreover, volunteers will be involved in other social activities like trekking and postering for awareness about legality and biodiversity.

Description of Workcamp: Project summary: In Chiaverano, a small and nice village at the feet of the Alps, the volunteers will support the local community project to reduce hydrogeological risks and so preventing damages due to possible landslides.

Description

Project: The village of Chiaverano is located up on the hills of la Serra Morena and is surrounded by chestnuts trees with old banks made by stone walls that must be maintained and if the case restored because the territory shows evidence of possible hydrogeological damage. The local community has put in place a specific project to avoid possible landslides: beyond the restoring of the walls it is needed an in depth cleaning of the woods and small torrents. The volunteers shall support the local community in this project.

Legambiente local group: The Legambiente Dora Baltea club takes the name from the river that flows through the Morenic Amphitheatre, born by the retirements of the Balteo glacier. All our activities are devoted to the preservation of our territory either monitoring new industrial settlement. We also participate to the national campaigns such as Clean Up the World, Alps Caravanning, Trees Festival. We cooperate with some other local clubs engaged in similar activities involving specifically young people.

Description

Project: With the aim of building solidarity in Sant'Elpidio a Mare, the workcamp will restore two greenhouses currently abandoned - in front of the cooperative «La Serra», that hosts young adults with disabilities. The greenhouses will constitute, then, a permanent project for the people of the centre, who will maintain them in their ordinary laboratories.

The volunteer will also contribute in the maintenance of the path that leads from La Serra to Santa Croce basilica, a fundamental structure for the religious, historic and artistic development of the town.

Legambiente local group: Legambiente Porto Sant'Elpidio was born in 1988; it is involved in all the environmental battles and campaigns carried out by the national Legambiente and in campaigns of environmental education in collaboration with schools and other associations. During its years of activity a lot of energy was spent to promote the historical memory and the identity of some important places, such as Fim (an old fertilizer factory currently abandoned) and an area called Orfeo Serafini, that was a football camp in front of the sea, freed from the risk of overbuilding.

Work: The volunteers will repair the greenhouses that guests of «La Serra» will use after summer holiday: with the support of an agronomist, they will set up some places for cultivation, that will be organized in the basis of periodicity. Labels and instructions for every plant will also be produced, so that the guests of the cooperative «La Serra» will be able to use these greenhouses.

Another activity will be the realization of the signals for the near trail that leads to the river Chienti and connect «La Serra» to the cathedral of Santa Croce.

Study part: experts of history, agriculture and food will ensure interactive learning between volunteers and local people.
