27.07 - 09.08.2014, RENO 10 vols (18-30)

Project partners: Peace Corps Volunteers, NGO ¿Djereło¿.

Project: Ukraine is occupying one of the leading places in Europe in the spread of HIV. The most critical situation is in the eastern regions of Ukraine and on the south. Lugansk region (the most eastern region of Ukraine) due to its specificity is a leader in Ukraine in this sphere. Lugansk region is a huge industrial area with all problems typical for such zones: pollution, poor ecological situation, limited opportunities for local people. Local youth have just few ways of spending their free time. In previous years international volunteers together with local youth created and decorated children¿s playground and space for running clubs. Experience of hosting foreign volunteers was unforgettable for local community.

In Rubizhne is situated HIV/Aids Regional Daycares Centre for youth and children (age 5-15 years old). Centre offers services for people living with HIV/AIDS and provides social rehabilitation for at-risk members of the community. Daily Centre serves around 160 persons. Many children are orphans or come from problem families. Centre administration tries to provide youth with different workshops, clubs, trainings and classes to vary leisure time and wake their interests to something new. This year administration decides to introduce intercultural atmosphere to everyday¿s routine of the clients of the Centre.

We plan that group of international volunteers together with 20 children who come from the poorest environment together will work and spend free time together. Also we plan to involve local youth activists.

Ultimately, the project is aimed at both renovating, as well as transferring technical and leadership skills to local youth volunteers. We plan to have study part ¿ international volunteers will have an opportunity to learn more about HIV infection, situation with HIV/AIDS in Ukraine and also share information about situation in their native countries. Also we plan meetings with local youth and schoolchildren.

The project is really important for the local community and for volunteers who want to help and to see results of their work. For many children the Centre is the only place where they can feel safely, eat and have a rest. We hope that contacts with international volunteers will make days of those children brighter.

Work: the task for the workcamp is to renovate and improve children¿s playground which was built by previous workcamp. The second task will be decorating of internal space (rooms, halls) of Daycares Centre in a creative way (pictures, symbols etc.). It is possibility to organise presentation about situation with HIV/AIDS in countries of participants.

Accommodation/Food: volunteers will be housed in Daycares Centre in rooms.
Food will be provided two times per day. Breakfast will be prepared by volunteers.

Location: town Rubizhne, Lugansk region, Ukraine.

Terminal: Lugansk.

Nearest Airport: Kiev Boryspil Airport (KBP) or Kiev International Airport (Zhuliany).

Leisure time: Ukraine is a wonderful place to visit during the summer. Volunteers will be given the opportunity to swim at the local lake, barbeque in the forest, enjoy outdoor sports.

What to bring: working clothes and shoes, information about HIV situation in your country, pictures/postcards from your country, flags, music, games, recipes. We will have the opportunity to go to the beach ¿ so, please, bring your swimming suit, slippers, sunscreen and towel. Bring mosquito protection spray/lotion. And of course, do not forget you good mood!

Language: English.

Remarks: alcohol is not welcomed on the project.

On the first day of the project (27.07.14) volunteers will meet in the office of Alternative-V in Kyiv and together will take an overnight train to the project site. Trip will take around 14 hours, one way ticket costs around 25 Euros.

Description of Workcamp: Alt-04 Pereyaslav-Khmelnyskyi
Kyiv Region 03.08 - 16.08.2014 RENO 12 vols (18+)

Project partner: Pereyaslav-Khmelnyskyi open-air museum.

Project: The camp is situated in the suburban part of Pereyaslav-Khmelnyskyi. This town has a rich history and a lot of places to see. It is situated on the banks of one of the most beautiful rivers in Ukraine - the Dnieper, 100 km to the south-east of Kyiv & the capital of Ukraine. Pereyaslav-Khmelnyskyi is one of the most important places in Ukrainian history. Pereyaslav-Khmelnyskyi has existed since the 10th century. It was a border stronghold of the Kievan Rus state and was overrun by Tatars in 1239. The town began to recover in the 16th century and emerged as a site of Ukrainian Cossack culture. In 1654, Bohdan Khmelnytskyi and his Cossacks met at Pereyaslav to agree that Ukraine, for protection against Poland, becomes a protectorate of Russia & breakdown in the Ukrainian history.

There are 17 museums and 7 magnificent parks in the city, so volunteers will enjoy this place.

Well-known in Ukraine - Open-air Museum of Folk Architecture is situated in Pereyaslav. Here you can see, among other things, authentic peasant huts of the times of old, smithies and several windmills of the eighteenth century. In fact, a village of the 17th & 19th centuries is recreated, complete with gardens and flowers around the houses with whitewashed walls and thatch roofs. In the houses you find icons and decorative towels & exactly the way it looked in the times of old. On the territory of the open-air museum, you can find other museums, one of which exhibits stone idols of the Scythian times of centuries before Christ.

Work: Open-air Museum of Folk Architecture is integral part of national Ukrainian heritage and is protected by special law. Alternative-V has been organizing this workcamp every year since 1996 repairing the historical objects and cultural monuments, participating in the work on the territory of the historic and cultural recreation area in Pereyaslav-Khmelnyskyi. Volunteers will help the staff of the Museum of Ukrainian Folk Architecture through different activities to restore the museum exhibits and to clean the territory of the museum.

Accommodation/Food: will be provided in dormitory of the local vocational school. Food will be provided 2 times per day. Breakfast will be prepared by volunteers themselves.

Location: Pereyaslav-Khmelnyskyi, 100 km to the south-east of Kyiv.

Terminal: Pereyaslav-Khmelnyskyi bus station.

Nearest Airport: Kyiv Boryspil Airport (KBP) or Kyiv International Airport

(Zhuliany).

Leisure time: As it was mentioned above there are a lot of museums in Pereyaslav-Khmelnytsky, so volunteers can explore the history and culture of the Central Ukraine. Trip to Kyiv (2 Euro one way by bus) can be organized. Sunbathing and swimming in the Dnipro River and the lake are possible.

What to bring: Working clothes, sleeping bag, swimming suit, a mat, pocket flashlight, shoes, sportswear, mosquito protection liquid, musical instruments and everything you need.

Description of Workcamp: Alt-06-14 Ancient Lviv: crossroads of cultures Lviv 10.08-24.08.14

Project: project will take place in Lviv - a major industrial and cultural center in the Western region of Ukraine. Lviv is a very beautiful and cozy European city with unique architecture and lots of nice restaurants and cafes. It is famous for its ancient cathedrals, churches, museums, art galleries, theatres. Lviv was founded in the mid-13th century. The city was located on the crossroads of trade routes that made it the center of trade and commerce and led to its rapid economic development. The medieval urban topography has been preserved virtually intact (in particular, there is evidence of the different ethnic communities who lived there), along with many fine Baroque and later buildings. The territory of central part of Lviv - 120 ha of the property at its centre now listed as a part of the World Heritage, was designated as a National Historical and Architectural Reserve. Stryiski Park was founded in 1879 and in summer 2009 it celebrated its 130th Birthday. This giant territory (54 ha) was a favorite place of locals for years. Cinema, galleries, restaurants were situated here. Unfortunately, last years were not so successful for the Park - because of bad financing now it is in poor condition. During this summer some renovation works in the park are planned by local authorities.

Work: The volunteers will work on the territory of Stryiski Park and possibly in some other parks located in the central part of the city. Volunteers will clean footpaths and runoff ditches on the sides of the paths, perform landscaping and other activities for improving the park grounds.

As one of the main objectives of the project is to raise awareness of the local community on the issues related to the World Heritage and to promote non-formal education methods in education about World Heritage, volunteers will be actively involved in preparing and running the following activities

- press-conference;

- World Heritage exhibition, prepared exclusively from the materials brought by the volunteers! - open for the citizens, were posters, photos, information and other materials brought by the volunteers about World Heritage sites and other unique places of their home countries will be exhibited;

- Workshop with children about World Heritage with the use of the educational materials provided by World Heritage Centre.

Accommodation/Food: volunteers will be accommodated in a student dormitory. Food will be provided 3 times per day.

Location: Lviv.

Terminal: Lviv bus or train station.

Nearest Airport: Lviv.

Leisure time: Lviv region has a lot of places of interests that is why you will not feel lack of historical places to visit: castles, monasteries, churches. Lviv itself is a beautiful city of authentic architecture, which is non-formal capital of Western Ukraine. There will an opportunity to visit many museums and other interesting places in Lviv.

What to bring: working gloves, comfortable footwear (strong shoes), working clothes, CDs, DVDs etc, musical instruments, detailed information about your country, national games, good mood and motivation.

Description of Workcamp: Alt-07 Poltava Poltava 27.08 - 09.09.2013 RENO/CULT 12 vols (18-30)

Project partners: Educational Complex ¿Parostok¿ (UNESCO Associated School).

Project: the project will be held in Poltava, Central Ukraine, for the second time. The city is historically known for the remarkable battle which took place near the city between Russian and Swedish armies during the Northern War in 1709. Some historians agree that Poltava battle marked the end of the Swedish Empire and birth of the Russian Empire.

Poltava is a beautiful town with about 300,000 residents. It¿s filled with green parks, historical monuments, fountains, restaurants and cafes.

Parostok is an educational complex founded in 1994 to provide its students with more than a school education. It strives to raise the children in a well-rounded, caring and educational environment. International volunteers will work together with school children.

Main component of the project is intercultural exchange between international participants and local schoolchildren and students. Based on previous year experience we decide to dedicate more time and efforts to this part of workcamp. We plan to involve schoolchildren and student from wide numbers of Poltava¿s schools and Universities. International volunteers will prepare and run presentations of their countries and educational systems especially.

Work: we invite volunteers for a wonderful intercultural exchange with our school children (10-17 years old). During first half of the day volunteers will help maintain and beautify the town areas by engaging such project as renovation of children¿s playground. Playgroud is situated in populous blockhouse areas of Poltava. Playground is used by local children, two nearby kindergartens and school. Now playground is in poor condition. Organisers plan with the help of sponsor (who will donate materials and tools) and international volunteers to renovate and to decorate playground. Your ideas are welcomed!

In the second half of the day volunteers will prepare and run presentations of their countries, traditions with the schoolchildren and local volunteers. In these cultural exchanges, we can learn about your country¿s popular games, sports, dances and songs, recipes and about educational system. Content and format of presentations will be created by volunteers.

Accommodation/Food: volunteers will stay in dormitory with all facilities. Breakfast will be prepared by volunteers. Lunch and dinner will be provided in school canteen.

Location: Poltava, Poltava region.

Terminal: Poltava.

Nearest Airport: Kyiv Boryspil Airport (KBP).

Leisure time: Ukraine is a wonderful place to visit during the summer. On the weekends, you will have free time for sightseeing in Poltava, visiting museums and a festival park, ice-skating, bowling, playing sports, dancing, and sunbathing and swimming on Poltava local beach.

What to bring: pictures/postcards from your country, flags, music, games, recipes, arts and craft ideas to make with the children, materials about educational system in your country. Musical instruments are welcome! Bring working clothes and shoes. We will have the opportunity to go to the beach ¿ so, please, bring your swimming suit, slippers, sunscreen and towel. Bring mosquito protection spray/lotion!

Language: English.

Remarks: alcohol is not welcomed on the project.

On first day of the project (27.08.2014) volunteers will meet in the office of Alternative-V in Kyiv and together with the campleader travel to project site. Trip will take 4 hours by bus or train, one way ticket costs around 15 euro.
