TECHNICAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE POLL SAMPLE (1st SURVEY 2008)

SUBJECT 2: VALUES AND IDENTITIES

Sphere National

Universe Spanish population of both sexes between 15 and 29 years of age.

Sample size 1442 interviews

Allocation Proportional

Sampling points 177 municipalities and 46 provinces

Sampling procedure Multi-stage, stratified by clusters, with selection of primary sampling units (municipalities) and secondary units (sections) with probability proportional to size, and the last units (individuals) by random routes and sex and age quotas. The strata have been formed by crossing the 17 autonomous communities with population size, divided into 7 categories: below or equal to 2,000 inhabitants; 2,001 to 10,000; 10,001 to 50,000; 50,001 to 100,000; 100,001 to 400,000; 400,001 to 1,000,000, and more than 1,000,000 inhabitants. The questionnaires have been completed through personal interviews in households.

Sampling error In the case of simple random sampling, with a confidence level of 95.5% (two sigma) and $P = Q$, the real sampling error is $\pm 2.61\%$.

- Stand on different controversial issues: marriage between persons of the same sex, squatting, the genetic selection of embryos for therapeutic purposes, assisting a person with an incurable disease to die when he/she asks for such help, application of the death penalty on persons who have committed serious crimes, and religious education in schools
