Description of Workcamp: CYVA 03 GRAZUTE REGIONAL PARK 20/07-31/07 ENVI 18-30 VOLS 8

PROJECT/WORK

Heavenly shore on earth - the best way to describe Grazute Regional Park. Park was founded for the protection of valuable lake, forested landscape of upper reaches of the River Sventoji with biodiversity and ethno-cultural treasures. There are more than 90 lakes. Lake Sventas is unique in the largest water swing. Antalieptes Marios with brilliant islands and peninsulas is a man-made lake, which has the most sophisticated configuration of shore in Lithuania. Lake Luodis (1320 ha) is the 6th biggest in Lithuania and has two sandy spits. The park is composed of landscape, telmological, geomorphic, hydrographic, and urban reserves. Many varieties of plants and animals are protected here.

The project is expected to restore during many years overgrown on Kiemionys castle mound and to remove overgrown in the Birds' island. Restoration of castle mound and restoration of Birds' island will include cutting by hand and removing grass and woody vegetation.

The project is expected to restore Luodis lake shore. Restoration of shore will include cutting by hand and removing reeds and woody vegetation.

The project is expected to clean up the boating race in Sventoji River as well. Participants will travel with canoes/boats down the Sventoji River. Cleaning will include cutting by hand natural obstacles in the river (such as log, dump), and collecting trashes from the water (such as plastic bottles, bags).

ACCOMMODATION/FOOD:

Volunteers will live in the administration building of the directorate of Grazute Regional Park. Volunteers will sleep in the conference room on the floor, so participants should bring sleeping bags and tourist carpets. There is a shower with hot water, wash basins, toilet, stove for cooking and a refrigerator. Cooking is done by volunteers themselves.

LEISURE TIME:

Free time can be organized independently by the volunteers because there are many opportunities for visiting interesting places. During the free time volunteers can rent bikes or canoes, and go for biking trip around Regional Park or canoe trip down Sventoji River, visit self-guided hiking trails. For relaxing a lake 1 km away is the best idea. There are many places for visiting in Zarasai district as well, such as Slyninka water mill, Monastery in Baltriskes, the oldest oak tree in east Europe (more than 1500 y.o.) and oldest Lithuania's wooden church in Stelmuze.

LOCATION:

Salakas town is 45 km away from Utena town in the eastern part of Lithuania. It is the largest town in Grazute Regional Park. Salakas was first time mentioned in

1496. It has a population of about 500 people. There is unique Sea museum (!), Nature visitors center. There are many tourists during the summer season: traditionally, biking trips by Great biking race, canoeing trips by Sventoji River begins in Salakas. The landscape of Grazute Regional Park is covered by forests. Grazute Regional Park became the 1st place winner in the EDEN (European Destinations of Excellence) project in 2010.

TERMINAL:

Kaunas or Vilnius International airports/bus stations, Utena bus station.

WHAT TO BRING:

Sleeping bags, tourist carpet, long-sleeved clothes; trousers; rain gear; anti mosquito cream; music instruments; tapes; CD's; your national games and recipes; songs; dances; ideas how to spend leisure time; swimming things; waterproofed shoes.

MEETING POINT:

The meeting point is in Utena.

More details and the address of the camp will be sent with the acceptance letter and the info sheet.

REGISTRATION FEE:

Description of Workcamp: CYVA 04 KREKENAVA REGIONAL PARK 03/08-14/08 ENVI 18-30 VOLS 8

PROJECT/WORK

Krekenava Regional Park protects the river Nevezis plains with its meadows, forests and swamps. The biggest Lithuanian central lowlands landscape value is Nevezis River valley with expressive curves of and impressive strings of riverbeds. Directly adherent to the valley and wooded plains is agrarian landscape intersected by swampy areas with creeks. The symbol of the regional park is the European bison. The first couple of them were brought here in 1969. Now, almost 20 bisons live here and another 20 roam free. A large part of the park is covered by forests, and the most important of them - the old oak. The forests are rich in broadleaf trees, rich in rare plant species. The park is also home for otter, beaver, hazel dormouse, deer, wild boar, roe deer, fallow deer, and bats.

In Krekenava Regional Park there are many attractions of cultural heritage: Pasiles bison farm, J.Tumo-Vaizganto Book smuggling Museum, "Girinio takas", Bakainiu mound, Cicinskas Hill, Burveliu hill, stone Rapolas, Daniliskes lime avenue, and so on. It is proposed to set out to travel pedestrians, bicycles, car routes. Districts can be overviewed by sailing down Nevezis River. Those who like quiet rest can stay at the resorts and rural tourism homesteads.

Volunteers tasks: Maintenance of natural and cultural heritage sites; collecting garbage near rivers and lakes; Work/interaction with local residents and park visitors.

ACCOMMODATION/FOOD:

Volunteers will live in Krekenava visitors' center. Sleeping will be organized in the conference hall (one common room of 70 square meters) on the floor, so please bring sleeping bags and mats). The building has a shower, washing basins, toilets, a cooker, a fridge, a microwave, and a kettle. Cooking will be done by volunteers (products will be provided).

LEISURE TIME:

Volunteers can arrange their free time independently. You will be able to take cognitive paths, visit sites of natural and cultural heritage, rent canoes to go down a river. The village of Krekenava is interesting in the events organized by the cultural center. For those who just want to relax it's best to choose one of the nature campsites.

LOCATION:

Krekenava town is 30 km from the 5th biggest city Panevezys. There are 1600 residents in Krekenava; it has a library, a post office, cultural center, Krekenava regional park visitors' center, and 7 shops.

TERMINAL VISIT TO THE KREKENAVA REGIONAL PARK VISITORS' CENTER

TERMINAL: Vilnius or Kaunas airports, bus/train stations.

WHAT TO BRING:

Sleeping bags, tourist mats, long-sleeved clothes, trousers, hats, light raincoats, waterproof boots, mosquito repellent, swimming clothes, things to make the group life more fun (music, games, cultural treats etc.)

Description of Workcamp: CYVA 06 KURTUVENAI REGIONAL PARK 31/08-13/09 ENVI 18-30 VOLS 8

PROJECT/WORK:

Wide changing landscapes from forests over wetlands to large fields - this would describe Kurtuvenai Regional Park just in some words. But with a deeper look, it's a protected area full of history and legends which is as natural now as it was in the past.

To hold this stadium of wonderful nature we issued this voluntary camp. The idea of this project is to rebuild the park as it was in the times of the manor house. The park might be one of the oldest in Lithuania. The first written sources date back to 1498. But the park was savaged in 20th century. Today the directorate of Kurtuvenai regional park cares for the old manor. In 2002 the park won the ESS Phare (European social survey) project which supported the clean-up. After this project the face of the park changed completely. A concrete street was replaced by a semi-circle way linking the church and the granary. The place where the Manor stood was marked with a fence. The aim of the project is to create preconditions for the retaining of the former Kurtuvenai manor and its application to visitors' needs. For example, in the Renaissance they planted flowers and vegetables in special shapes. Later foreign plants became fashionable. Afterwards and until today the park tries to give a picture of what it was at the end of the 19th century by replanting local varieties of trees and plants like oaks, black cherry, jasmine and hazelnuts. This project will encourage the development of park's free time areas, application of fishery ponds for recreation goals, and appearance of new services of horse tourism, catering, accommodation as well as other recreation services.

ACCOMMODATION/FOOD:

The volunteers will sleep in tents our new campsite Kurtuvenai near to the orchard, in the center of the park. The ancient wooden gardener's house was rebuilt on diggings four years ago. Bathroom installations are available for each gender. Cooking is done by volunteers themselves. A kitchen with cooking facilities is provided.

LEISURE TIME:

The free time will be organized independently by the volunteers. A shared aim could be for example the "Hill of crosses" which is just 30 km away from Kurtuvenai and reachable by bus. Or visiting the famous "Svile" springs, o Juodle lake, which is known for its plenty species of birds. For relaxing a lake 3 km away is the best idea, it's also possible to hire bicycles to get there.

LOCATION:

Kurtuvenai is a small village with just 300 inhabitants and 20 km away from

Siauliai, the 4th biggest city in Lithuania. The village has some sightseeing to offer, for example the church, the granary and the old cemetery. In the village you have the opportunity to buy food in two shops, have dinner or lunch in the pub or take a lesson in the horse riding center. The regional park is also full of fishponds, where you have the chance to go fishing. There is one bus stop in the center of Kurtuvenai, where you have the chance to go to Siauliai.

TERMINAL:

Klaipeda sea port (about 140 km away), Vilnius airport (about 220 km away), Siauliai bus station (20 km away), Kaunas airport (about 180 km away), Palanga airport (90 km away)

WHAT TO BRING:

Sleeping bags, long-sleeved clothes; trousers; rain gear; anti mosquito cream; music instruments (optional); your favorite music; your national games and recipes; songs; dances; ideas how to spend leisure time; swimming things; waterproof shoes.

MEETING POINT:

The meeting point is in Kurtuvenai. With prior agreement small groups can be picked up in Siauliai. More details and the address of the camp will be sent with acceptance letter and info sheet.
