The economy of the Tibetans is on tourism whereas that of local villagers is purely dependent on agriculture. Project will be held in sub-urban area of Mcleodganj. The volunteers will have opportunity to visit the seat of spiritual leader, the Dalia Lama and other historical Hindu temples.
