**DESCRIPTION OF WORKCAMP:**

Centre Couleurs du Monde is a reception centre for asylum seekers managed by Belgian Red Cross. It can host up to 200 people who have asked for asylum in Belgium. Their stay in the centre is temporary and lasts until a decision is taken regarding a possible refugee status. The centre provides such services as accommodation, food, medical and social counselling, schooling and educational courses, cultural, sport events etc. One of the most important points is that the centre is open to the world, by promoting international exchanges with volunteers from all over the world. That is the main purpose of the camp ? intercultural exchanges thanks to a voluntary project. Before these people may start their new lives, their refugee status has to be proven and accepted. While waiting for the documents that will enable them to remain legally in our country, the asylum seekers are accommodated in this centre. People living there await the solution concerning their administrative status. They never know what tomorrow may bring to them. Therefore, residents often found themselves overwhelmed by feelings of relief and anguish, hope and disappointment. **DESCRIPTION OF WORKCAMP:**

Since 90 years, the centre Les Glaïeuls hosts children who have family difficulties. The centre, approved by ONE (National Office for Childhood), host 16 children between 2 and 12 years old. These children go to school near the centre; and the staff members help them to do the homework, and take care of them... Each day, 2 different volunteers will participate in the daily life of the centre: your ideas are welcome to organise some activities with the kids, the staff member of the centre will help you to organise these activities. **DESCRIPTION OF WORKCAMP:**

Aisnagué is a non-profit organization located in a very small village called Lafosse and situated at the heart of the Ardennes region. With an old traditional water mill, the purpose of the partner association is to produce some oil and flour. This year Aisnagué will collaborate with several associations of the region to welcome the volunteers. These organisations are all focusing on local production and local distribution channel. Among the different organisations, there will be other mills, a brewery, a cheese maker...

A lot of outdoor tasks with those partners: re-point channel walls, cut and prune branches, cleaning and repair the old mechanisms of milling, maintenance of the river banks, pick the vegetables... A short study part will be organized by the different organisations in order to introduce properly the local distribution channel and their values to the volunteers.

The volunteers will organize a cooking team each day. You'll have the possibility to have organic vegetables from a local producer and you'll cook your bread by yourself with the baker's oven of the village, the nearest shop is about 10km.

**LOCATION:**

Lafosse is a very beautiful village but very small and isolated. It could be impossible to move in another city during the week. If you like the birdsongs and noise of the stream, it will be the perfect place for you. The nearest train station is situated at about 20km from there. During the week-end, you will have the opportunity to move from the wild to the civilization ;) by sightseeing for example in Liège, Brussels or Namur.

**DESCRIPTION OF WORKCAMP:**

The Marche-en-Famenne workcamp is the outcome of the collaboration between municipal authorities and a local non-profit organization. More than ten years ago, the mayor and deputies wanted to develop international contacts for the local youngsters. GRIMM association was just beginning to work on the protection of the local life framework and promoting models of sustainable development. Their members had a full load of ideas but were short of hands to realize them. Thus, they came to the idea of involving volunteers from all over the world. Since then, the municipality makes its buildings available every summer and welcomes foreign youngsters. GRIMM members organize the work. With the help from the volunteers, they are eventually able to realize the projects they dreamt about. Their actions are based on the following philosophy: Nature belongs to everyone. Les Chemins d'Ariane, located in Ciney, is an institution recognized as 'Medical and Social Institutes' (IMS). The mission of an IMS is to welcome, help, accompany people in need (disabled, old and convalescent people) through different kinds of social and medical services. The Chemins d'Ariane is a residential service that hosts around 330 people with a mental disability and or illness.
