DESCRIPTION OF WORKCAMP:

Chookseosa Temple was founded in 673 during the reign of a King Munmu of Shilla Dynasty. The founder, National Master Ui-Sang, dedicated his life to Korean Buddhism. Chookseosa means where the eagle, a symbol of wisdom resides, and also symbolizes the Bodhisattva. Ven Muyeo, one of the contemporary Korean Seon masters, has devoted himself to rebuilding Chookseosa. He has taught Seon meditation for couple of decades at Chuookseosa. Seon practice is the journey to perceive a true answer of the question about who I am, where I came from and where I am going to. This project is mainly based on ¿Temple Stay¿ programme which is experiencing Monk¿s life. You can find more information through official website of Temple Stay. <http://eng.templestay.com/> Work: Participants will renovate the temple and around. And they will also join in the Buddhist camp for youth for experiencing temple culture and intercultural learning through various methods. Participants should respect the life style of the temple during a project such as wake up early morning, early morning service, sleeping, eating, etc. It wouldn¿t be easy but it will bring lots of fresh and healthy mind and body.

Jaecheon(<http://goo.gl/LI67Ca>) is about 200 km away from Seoul and famous with beautiful mountains around. There are some social issues regarding the youth empowerment, caring disabled people and dealing with the aging society. Host organization has been working for a long time to solve this. Participants will take part in two projects for ¿youth and a local elder¿ during this project. They will organize a youth camp to develop the global competencies of local youth through a dynamic international cultures and programs. Participant will also help physically and economically disadvantaged local elders by making better living condition. In addition, there will be cultural exchange with local people. Work: As an assistant of youth camp, participants will organize and run the activities related with their own cultures such as languages, traditional dance and games, song and so on. Participants will also do mural painting to decorate a local village and maintain houses and facilities for the elder who are disadvantaged physically and economically.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKCAMP:

Namhansanseong was designed as an emergency capital for the Joseon dynasty (1392; 1910), in a mountainous site 25 km south-east of Seoul. Built and defended by Buddhist monk-soldiers, it could accommodate 4,000 people and fulfilled important administrative and military functions. It is the only fortress that has been used as an emergency palace during a war thus has a historically significant meaning to the history of Korea. In recognition of its value, Namhansanseong was designated as a UNESCO World Heritage site in 2013. But, so far it is more famous for a hiking, rock climbing and driving destination for local residents and visitors. In addition, many people have no idea that it is a World Heritage site. The aim of this project is to promote the importance and value of Namhansanseong as a World Heritage and preserving it. Work: Participants will organize the global culture camp for youth not only to give them awareness of world heritage site and know more about the importance of world heritage but also to teach how the other country treat the world heritage.
